Wind turbines get thumbs-up

WIND turbines on people's homes have been given the thumbs-up from the people of Leamington, Warwick and Kenilworth, a survey shows

And following the first ever planning application in the district for a home turbine, two more have been submitted - with more to follow if they are successful.

Å project is underway involving sustainable energy group Action 21, micro energy provider Encraft, and Warwick District and Warwickshire County councils.

A number of pilot sites have been identified for turbines,

which will be monitored over the course of a year to gauge their effectiveness. Following on from the groundbreaking first applica-

tion on a house in Leamington - which we revealed recently the two most recent submis sions are for a Kenilworth house and the tip on Princes Drive.

The team behind the project recently carried out a survey on the streets of Leamington, Warwick and Kenilworth - which revealed a surprising level of support for the turbines, which have been

labelled eyesores by conservationists in other parts of the country.

Of the 78 people quizzed, some 81 per cent said they would support turbines on neighbouring houses, while only eight per cent said they would object if their neigh-bours applied for planning permission.

Matthew Rhodes of Encraft said: "We were surprised by the results, as we were expecting more opposition.

"But they are only suitable for certain types of property. They require structur-ally-sound gable ends, and cannot be fit-ted to chimpana". ted to chimneys.

Micro wind turbines are around 1.75 metres tall, and mounted on poles 2.2 metres high. They cost between \$1,500 and \$2,000 to install, and can provide between ten and 20 per cent of a household's annual electricity.

Within the next few years the government is expected to make them 'permit-ted developments', meaning they will not need planning permission, Mr Rhodes added

The application is expected to be considered at the Warwick District Council planning meeting on September 20.
